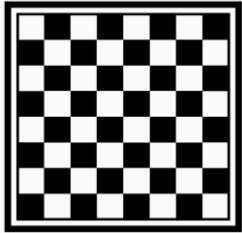


# Manchester Social Chess Club

## What is it?

A **weekly gathering** of chess players in a **pub** in the **centre of Manchester**.

Play **casual games** with or without a clock. Meet other chess players, look over recent games.

Usually 6 to 18 players each week with a wide range of abilities.

- Free informal training from stronger players (usually a 200 ECF strength player available)
